



HEALTH PRECAUTIONS AT McCORMICK WOODS GOLF CLUB

The wellbeing of our team members and customers is of paramount importance. We are closely monitoring the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and World Health Organization's statements regarding the COVID-19 cases and following guidelines from these agencies as well as the local health departments. Our team members consistently practice protocols designed to improve hygiene and sanitation as well as prevent illnesses. Considering the recent COVID-19, we have increased these efforts significantly, including:

- Practicing social distancing at all times, including in our Golf Shops during the registration process and encouraging golfers to practice social distancing throughout their round. Areas of note will be on the tee boxes and greens.
- Single rider carts are available to members and guests, when available, for no additional fees. Golf carts will be cleaned after every use. Scorecards, pencils, tees, and towels will be removed from golf carts in order to eliminate touch points. Guests will be asked to remove all items and trash from their carts after their round.
- Bunker rakes have been removed from the course. Golfers will be asked to smooth bunkers using their feet or golf clubs.
- Cup liners on our greens (the hole) have been slightly modified in order to eliminate the need for touching flagsticks or reaching into holes to retrieve golf balls.
- Increasing the cleaning of high-volume, high-touch areas, including golf cart surfaces, counters and door handles.
- Monitoring health departments at the city, state and federal levels to ensure we receive the latest updates and protocols.
- Distributing critical information among key staff members and business partners to help prevent illness.
